**Important Guidelines**

Applicants must reside in Escambia County or Santa Rosa County, Florida, and/or be a current student of a music teacher who teaches in one of those counties.

The application must be filled out completely. If you have any questions, please contact the Music Department (850) 474-2147 or (850) 857-6295.

Students who qualify for this competition will be assigned audition times about **two weeks** before the competition.

Please note that previous scholarship winners MAY NOT compete in the same category again. They MAY compete in a different category from that which they previously won.

**Each student is required to perform two contrasting selections**, each from a different period of music (Renaissance, Baroque, Classical, Romantic, 20<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> Century).

Contestants will have ten minutes total to perform both works. In case of longer compositions, the jury will stop the contestants at the appropriate time.

All instrumental and vocal works performed with piano must use live accompaniment. No recordings are permitted. Teachers may accompany their own students or another teacher's students.

One original score is required for the judges. Scores for the remaining two judges may be photocopied. Please mark the measure numbers, as it will help the judges reference their remarks. (Scores will be returned after the competition.)

Memorization is not required, but may be taken into account by the judges.

Decision of the judges will be final and binding. Winners will be chosen on merit. If there is only one contestant for a particular scholarship, the applicant will be expected to audition and demonstrate a high (winner) quality performance in order to be declared the winner by the judges.

Judges will complete critique sheets. Each contestant will receive their critique sheets after the competition.

Music teachers, students, parents and friends should NOT speak to any of the judges.

Warm up time (10 minutes) will be provided in an assigned practice room.

The competition is open to the public.

**Competition winners will be required to perform at the Music Study Club /UWF Pre-Collegiate Competition Winners' Recital at the UWF Center for Fine and Performing Arts, Building 82, on Sunday March 4, 2018 at 3:00pm.**

The concert is free and open to the public.
