The contestants will have ten minutes total to perform both works. In case of longer compositions, the jury will stop the contestants at the appropriate time. All instrumental and vocal works performed with piano must use live accompaniment. No recordings are permitted. Teachers may accompany their own students or another teacher's students.

At least one original score is required for the judges.

Memorization is not required, but may be taken into account by the judges. Decision of the judges will be final and binding. Judges will complete critique sheets. Each contestant will receive their critique sheets after the competition.

Winners will be chosen on merit. If there is only one contestant for a particular scholarship, the applicant will be expected to audition and demonstrate a high (winner) quality performance in order to be declared the winner by the judges.

Music teachers, students, parents, and friends should NOT speak to any of the judges. Warm up time (10 minutes) will be provided in an assigned practice room.

Scholarship winners will be required to perform at the Music Study Club /UWF Scholarship Winners Recital at UWF, Music Hall, Center for Fine and Performing Arts, Building 82, on April 7th, Sunday afternoon at 3:00. The concert is free and open to the public.
